Covid 19 Protocol

October 3, 2021

On October 3, 2021 the Church council reviewed the COVID Protocol for Community Congregational Church based on CDC and Kewaunee Public Health recommendations.

- Face coverings are strongly recommended for guests and members who are not fully vaccinated.
 - o Masking indoors is “recommended and encouraged” but not mandated.
- Social Distancing will be maintained at the recommended 6 feet at individuals' discretion.
 - Maintain appropriate procedures for handwashing and sanitizing.
- We respect and support guests and members that continue to use face coverings for personal reasons.

Positive Covid Case presented in church: What to do ...

- A member that has been at church and tests positive should contact the Moderator. This information will be confidential.
- The positive individual will be interviewed to determine if there were any close contacts at the church.
 - Any close contacts will be informed by a church official or the positive individual.
- CDC and Public Health guidelines will be followed with the recommendation that the COVID positive individual does not return to fellowship for 14 days after the positive result and symptoms are no longer present.
- We will make every attempt to keep all members safe in all settings in our church community.

We are aware that cases continue to increase in our community and state and acknowledge that each of us have the responsibility to respect, honor, and love each other. This is a time like no other that requires flexibility and understanding.
